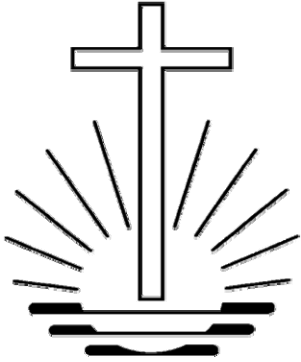

May we also love him, remember and think of Him and do everything to make Him happy.

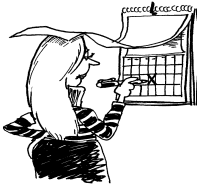
D.Ap. Klingler encourage all children of God to be open to his/her bearer of blessing. This is the only way to happiness and experience joy in the Lord.
