What is the best age to marry?

DEv. Andrew Latorcai Visits Makati Choir

Last July 17, 2004 District Evangelist Andrew Latorcai visited Makati Choir and Orchestra to oversee how the church music has developed in Asia and make plans for the future growth. The Choir and Orchestra performed their best. D.Ev. Latoircai is impressed.

He left some important messages we want to recall as follows:

- 1. The choir work is not a responsibility but a joy and love.
- 2. The blessing is on the preparation, in the choir practise and not on the day of performance.
- 3. Keep on learning new songs.
- 4. Make music an outreach, the community is invited to a non-threathening invitation like choir concerts, music is non-threathening.
- 5. Choir leader introduce new songs.
- 6. Don't sing new songs until its perfect.
- 7. Sing original tagalog hymns composed by Filipinos.
- 8. Recruit more male choir especially brothers for bass and tenor.
