Dear Apostle Hebeisen,

Bisexual/Homosexual is it forbidden? Then if it's forbidden, why there's so many of them and it's O.K. now a days. What's going to happen with them? Is there anything we can do to help them?

#### ANSWER:

Homosexuality is not fully researched yet. Whether it is a inclination with which one is born or whether such has been acquired by influences in ones life is not proven. Homosexuality is also not proven until one is fully grown up.

Based on biblical record the Church cannot approve to homosexuality. The biblical record cannot be ignored however we simply do not know where it comes from and accept homosexually inclined people full hearted in our fellowship. They are respected and have the right to have their souls cared for like everybody else.

Even though Homosexuals should abstain from carrying a ministry or be in a teaching position they should not be excluded or discriminated in any way.
