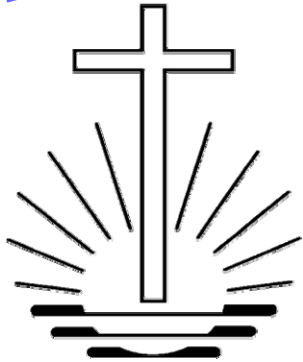

APOSTLE LETTER BOX

Dear Apostle Hebeisen,

Is it possible to have a seminar for the youth together with the Priestly ministers about "Sexual Harassment" in order to know the effect of sexual harassment to one's spiritual as well as natural life?



ANSWER:

This is a plane matter of planning. I personally prefer the subject of sexual harassment is presented to the Youth together with the church position paper on sexuality.

Youth might have different questions than Brothers in the Ministry. Therefore separate Seminars would be preferable.

This would also tie in with our new doctrine about Sin and Guilt, our position paper on Sexual behaviors and pastoral care on sexual abuse which are for ministers.
