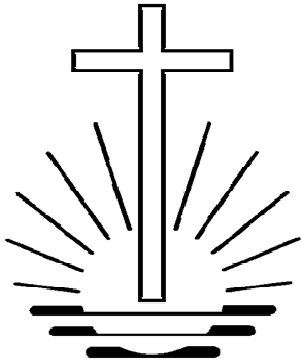

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Editorial

My dear youth,

This month of March our Chief Apostle Leber wrote a circular for all New Apostolic Youth. His advice was "Be careful in your life!"

Be careful with yourself and above all with your faith, prayers, attitude towards the brothers, and faithfulness in sacrificing, associates, and opinions.

Be careful with your faith: Apostle Paul says that some "have suffered shipwreck" in their faith (1 Timothy 1: 19). A ship can be shipwrecked when it leaves the safe shipping channel. For us the "safe shipping channel" is the apostle's doctrine. "Take heed to yourself

and to the doctrine, continue in them" (1 Timothy 4: 16). This is the only way to reach our goal. Not through religious views and opinions.

Be careful with your prayers: As young people you generally begin and end the day in prayer with your parents. But do you still take an active interest in these prayers or do you not even listen anymore? Our Chief Apostle strongly recommends that you also offer up your own prayers. Please do not let any day go by without speaking with God.

Be careful with your attitude towards the brothers: Please see in them God's emissaries. Trustfully turn to them in special situations. They will gladly pray for you.

Be careful in your faithfulness in sacrificing: Many of you young people will not have a regular income. Yet now and then you perhaps get the opportunity to earn some pocket money. Please take sacrificing seriously! First consider our heavenly Father rather than your own desires. This will yield blessings.

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Be careful with whom you associate: Evil company corrupt good habits.

Be careful with opinions: Many people nowadays are of the opinion that they no longer need the church. However, they do not see the need to take Jesus current advice.

Carelessness happens when we are not careful. Our ship of faith will safely dock the final destination, eternal fellowship with God, if we are careful.

I remembered one of your answers in the past issue of our Youth link, which we need to look on the Spiritual side of our Bearer of blessing. And now my question is "How can I absorb and apply to my soul the word in the Divine service if that minister who preach us, is opposite to what He is doing in his own life?" When I go to church I asked for the forgiveness of my sin, but sometimes instead of forgiving my sins I only commit another sin because my mind tells me that I need to listen to what He is preaching because he is my bearer of blessing but my heart and soul doesn't want to listen. Please help me about this matter. Thank you very much.

ANSWER:

You are very right; such a scenario belongs to the most difficult in our life of faith. All men have shortcomings and still God chooses them. However such a situation can become tough.

Now first analyze inside you. Ask yourselves, are these now very grave trespasses this Brother has made. If yes then he needs help, too. Could it however be that the problems are pure personal, misunderstandings maybe?

Are the problems this Brother has, only issues of characteristics? Maybe he does not know he hurts somebody with his behavior. Try to talk to him privately and if that is not possible you must open up to a person of confidence because carrying such a feeling in your heart will weaken your faith.

If this Brother leads a life totally in contradiction to Christ's teaching and your soul is tormented with what you know about him, you must again speak to a Minister of your confidence or a friend who will bring the matter up to carriers of responsibility in the church, anonymous if necessary.

In the end the Apostle must decide and find a solution. I am praying for you that you shall soon find peace.
