YOUTH DIVINE POWER



My Dear Youth and Youth Leaders, *and of love and of a sound mind” (2 Timothy 1: 7)*

There may be fear also amongst the youth, namely anxieties or worries that can provoke lack of hope. I am thinking of problems at school or on the job, of the desire to find a partner, also of difficulties for reasons of health or for family reasons. This human fear may dampen our joy and make the youth weak.

We want to resist all this with the godly power!

“For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power

The youth too has some of this godly power, because all of us have received “the power from on high”, namely the Holy Spirit.

We can mobilize the divine power when we

- align our attitude with the word of God
- receive Holy Communion in a worthy manner
- daily practice prayer life

With this divine power we have inner strength. Like Jesus while He was with His disciples on the sea. And their boat was hit by a devastating storm. His disciples feared for their lives but the Lord Jesus was asleep. He is not afraid, He is at peace. Only if one has inner power, one has sovereign peace.

I wish all youth who experience the storm of life to *recharge your hearts with divine power out of every divine service and fellowship.* And while we put into motion the word of God by leading our life according to God’s will, by resisting temptation, by bearing injustice and by confessing our faith, the more this divine power increase.

Like hydro power. While the strong water current is in motion the more electrical power it creates. Like with wind power. While the strong wind moves the blades the more electrical power it creates.

The more the Holy Spirit in us has room in our

THE NEXT LUZON YOUTH DAY

Since the last Youth Day in Cavite many a youth is now asking where we are in the next Luzon Youth Day on November 7-9, 2008.

I would like now to report

the results of the survey for the venue conducted by myself and Deacon Jay-ar Borromeo.

We propose PARAISO BEACH RESORT, at Sariaya, Quezon.

The place has an Olympic size swimming pool located in front of the air conditioned dama de noche apartelle where the girls will camp. It has a nice veranda where one can relax and chat. In front on the apartelle is a nice landscape where the youth can play badminton.

The boys will camp in Waling-waling room located in front of the beach. It has two big rooms located on the 2nd floor on top of the picnic hall. The picnic hall will serve as the kitchen and dining place.

The plan is to arrive Friday afternoon and have an 18th birthday celebration of one of our youth in the evening. Saturday will be filled with youth discussion to be followed by games. Such as basketball, volleyball, obstacle course, sack race, and tug-of-war. The host youth group will be Lopez, Quezon. They also prepared games and surprises that will also be memorable for all. The evening will be filled with music and singing beside the beach around a bonfire.

The District Youth Service will be conducted at the Pavilion Hall. After the service we will treasure

again spiritual gifts we shared together in our fellowship. This will strengthen us to continue to reach the goal of our faith together.

Invited participants are youth delegates from
 LUZON SOUTH (Sorsogon, Albay, Goa, Calabanga North, Calabanga South, Naga, Daet, Lopez, Lopez Mountain, Catanauan)
 LUZON CENTRAL (Batangas, Mindoro, Cavite, Laguna North, Laguna Central, Laguna East, Quezon North, Metro Manila, Rizal, Bulacan)

LUZON NORTH (Bataan, Zambales, Pampanga, Nueva Ecija, Pangasinan South, Pangasinan North, La Union, Baguio, Abra, Ilocos Norte, Isabela)

It is estimated that 150 participants will come. It is estimated that the cost per participant will be P1, 000.00.

The Youth Leaders are now advised to submit the list of participants to RYL Sh. Depaz. Youth Leaders are now instructed to promote savings and create a youth fund for the event. We still have four (4) months to prepare. If every youth will save P250.00/month this will complete his/her cost sharing. Or each youth can have a piggy bank and save P10/day from your school allowance. Or collect old newspaper and old bottles and bring it to junkshop. Or save money on your cell phone e-load.

Whatever ways and means, please bear in heart and mind that what you have done as an offering and sacrifice to the success of the youth fellowship will serve as a blessing to you and to all.

This question is always in my mind and I cannot refuse to think of it, can you explain clearly if there is a sin that is never can be forgiven by God? What is it? Is there a mortal and immortal sin? Can you please differentiate it? Thank you.

ANSWER:

Dear SJ,

In new apostolic theology we do not differentiate between mortal and immortal sin. However we have a precise understanding of the difference between “sin” and “guilt” There is an elaboration available on this subject. If you are interested in details please let us know. We gladly give you a copy.

Jesus said that blasphemy against the Holy Spirit cannot be forgiven. We thereby often think this is the sin against the Holy Spirit. What exactly it is only God can judge. I personally believe to commit such a sin is to knowingly destroy what God has built up. Even Saul who persecuted the Christians was finding forgiveness and became Apostle Paul. It is really only God, who looks at the heart, who decides what cannot be forgiven.

The sacrifice of Christ established forgiveness of sin. How important for all of us come to the Divine Service and seek forgiveness under the word of absolution and the fellowship with Christ in Holy Communion. Let us always be thankful for this offer of Grace and never reject it.
