IN all youth days the Apostle Gabriel used textword of our Chief Apostle Leber in Cape Town Youth Day attended by 26,000 South African youth.

Here are the Highlights from our Youth Day Divine Service...

EXODUS 34: 29

What do the textword means?

When Moses went up to the mountain called Sinai to encounter God and receive the Ten Commandments something special happened to Moses. His face started to shine brightly. However, Moses did not know

that his face shone. When he finally came down the mountain again and meet with his people they hardly could look at Moses because his face shone so brightly.

How do we apply the message from the Youth Day Service to us?

Well, just as with Moses, every time we meet with God in the divine services we should b affected. People should recognize something special, a certain brilliance in us. What should people recognize in us?

- **DEEP PEACE** – we are children of peace
- **INNER JOY** – A joy knowing that I'm a child of God and our dear Lord is coming soon
- **TRUST IN GOD** - People should see in us a special confidence and courage to do what pleases God
- **LOVE FOR GOD AND HIS WORK** – We should have the desire to contribute to our congregation

and support God's work

Moses put a veil on his face. Please do not put a veil on your face and let your light shine before men. When do we put a veil on our face?

- When we are silent and do not confess that we are a child of God
- When we are arrogant and proud thinking "I can do it alone!". No, we depend on God
- When we put the natural striving first. Let us put God first.
- When we have fellowship with men who don't esteem our faith.

The shine in the face of Moses in time decreases. In time also the shine in us will decrease, but we know when we return to the divine service and seek His closeness, our shine will return.

What is the best reason to be happy as a New Apostolic?
